Report on day's events:

Scratches – Vets 2 Stewards 3

10:15 – Received a call from Trainer Daniel Stevenson that his horse “By Royal Appointment” slated to compete in today's eighth race hurt itself last night and will not be able to run today. Advised he is required to submit a vet scratch to the race office.

Races:

Race 1 – Clear, following the race #3 “Kiss Me Im Here” unseated its rider Ed Walton, Mr. Walton is off the rest of his mounts.

Race 2 – Clear

Race 3 - #3 “Dragon Wagon” ridden by Cory Spataro was off slow.

Race 4 – Stewards Inquiry and Trainer claim of foul by Joe Tavares (COF) of #4 “Tellin Me All” ridden by Chelsey Willick against #3 “Bending Over” ridden by Corrine Andros leaving the gate. Corrine said her horse broke sharply in and did her best to straighten. Chelsey said her horse broke good and was forced over a couple paths by Corrine's horse. Regan Knowles aboard #2 “Hanover Hill Stoli” said his horse broke a bit slow but was then in a bad spot when the outside horses moved over onto him. After review it is apparent the #4

breaks in hard first couple jumps interfering with the horses inside, #4 was disqualified from second and placed last behind #2.

Race 5 – The Ontario Sires Stakes Futurity – Clear

Race 6 – Clear, Breath analysis retest following the race.

Race 7 - #5 “Rouge River Cartel” threw a front shoe in the paddock and it could not be replaced, unable to remove the opposite shoe and the trainer requested the horse be scratched. The horse was subsequently a Stewards Scratch. Race Clear

Race 8 - #6 “Caraways Rare Wine” ridden by Ten Harriott and #8 “Uaintseennothingyet” ridden by Lloyd DeSouza were both off slow.

Claims:
