# Backstretch:

The gate was functioning properly and there was no interference from the Assistant Starter, therefore the horse was deemed to have received a fair start.
- Test strips were utilized in race one and two.

#### R2:

- Stewards' inquiry reviewed the break by #2 Spy for the Senate (J.B. Botello), (finished first). The doors for the #2 open slower than the rest, the horse is wearing a flipping halter that caused the doors to open slowly. #2 was deemed to have received a fair start. Also, the horse won the race and could not have achieved a better position.
