- #1 Hawkin the Straw (Cristian Benitez) was fractious in the gate and was subsequently scratched by the Association Veterinarian.

Race 6:

- #3 Imontherush (Ismael Mosqueira) was fractious in the gate and was subsequently scratched by the Association Veterinarian.

Race 7:

- The Stewards reviewed the start of this race due to the fact the six-horse field was shifted outside one spot. For example, #1 was in the #2 stall and #3 was in the #4 stall and so on. Each horse was in the correct stall in relation to each other and this had no bearing on the outcome of the race. Starter Ray Singh stated that they had loaded them in the correct order but over one stall as noted, by mistake.

Race 8:

- Inquiry X2
- First inquiry, Stewards inquiry and Jockey claim of foul #6 Hot to Trotta (Ramiro Castillo), (finished fifth and was placed fourth) on #2 Caraways Angels Air (Tony Phillips), (finished second and was placed fifth). On the break #2 bears outward and interferes with #4 Quick Willy (Cassandra Jeschke), (finished third and was placed second), #5 Paganas Boy (Ismael Mosqueira), (finished fourth and was placed third) and #6. #2 finished second and was placed fifth for causing interference to #4, #5 and #6. There will be no penalty to Jockey Tony Phillips as he does try to correct the horse as he is moving outward.
- Second inquiry reviewed the break by #7 Expediant (Cristian Benitez), (finished seventh). #7 reared on the break and received a fair start.
